Our Aims

- To improve quality of life for the students and families of the Pearl of Africa Children's Choir schools in Kamuzinda and Bunjakko and to make a real and direct difference to rural Ugandan villages struggling with poverty.
- To give students from Richard Lander School the chance to make a difference to young people in Africa. To provide our students with a cultural experience they will never forget.
- To provide Lander4Uganda students with work experience in teaching, fundraising, donation distribution, budget management, carpentry, brick laying and land management.
- Every student at Richard Lander School maintains links with other cultures and has the opportunity to support our partner schools in Uganda through L4U.
- To provide donors with the security of knowing that every penny we raise will benefit a Ugandan as we will personally oversee the distribution process.

Last Year's Fundraising

The funds raised in 2023 allowed students to: complete and fund major renovations to Nazarene School, Kamuzinda; finishing the school hall which was started in 2019, building a new toilet block, painting the Kindergarten inside and out and replacing all the broken windows, fixing the play park, fixing the

guttering and rainwater collection across the site, planting hundreds of trees..

In Bunjakko, L4U provided solar power, overlocking machines and materials to the DT block, completely refurbished the school kitchen, installing energy saving stoves and replacing the floor, completed a carpentry project building desks, tables and chairs, planted crops.

In both schools L4U hosted feasts, sports and talent competitions, games nights and craft nights for students. The team distributed food parcels to the elderly, sick and poor and hosted 'bra drops' for the women of both communities.

The L4U team also delivered nearly a ton of donated books, clothing, stationery, sports equipment, medical supplies, bras, shoes, laptops, sanitary items.. This was divided between Ugandan families we support. Everything was gratefully received!
