Yellow Fever Vaccinations in School

As Yellow Fever vaccinations are necessary for entry to Uganda, we have been asking you to make appointments with your GP or travel clinic to get this done and we know many of you have already done this.

However, St Agnes Surgery have now kindly offered vaccinate students and staff on the Uganda 2025 trip *in school* if there is sufficient demand. This group vaccination session will happen on **Wednesday 26th March**.

If your child has not been vaccinated against Yellow Fever yet and you would like them to have it done by the St Agnes Surgery nurses on 26th March, here in school, please:

- Fill out the consent form at the bottom of this letter.
- Fill out the NHS Temporary Service form (top half). There is a second carbon copy sheet of paper which you will need to line up to create a duplicate. Please use a ball point pen. It's important that the students date of birth and GP surgery sections are complete.
- **Please return these forms ASAP to Mr Morgans at Main Reception as we need to let St Agnes Surgery know how many students are taking up this offer.**
- Pay for the vaccination on ParentPay – you will need to add it to your basket and then pay. The cost will be £66.30. We need you to pay for it by **Thursday 20th March** to ensure all payments have cleared before vaccination day and we can pay St Agnes Surgery.
- If your child is on the Turing Scheme, you just need to fill out the form and return it to Mr Morgans as the scheme will pay for the vaccination.
